Camino de Santiago fans and walking enthusiasts in Limerick shouldn't miss a Camino talk taking place on Wednesday February 3 at 7pm.

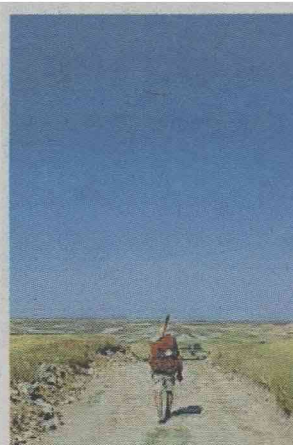
